Identity Theft a Concern For All

Sharon Shaw, assist Attorney General, Consumer Protection & Public Health Division, presented the program at Monday's meeting.

Sharon pointed out that preventing identity theft requires constant vigilance and a little extra caution when it comes to handling your personal information. She said when you order your next book of checks, consider having only your initials printed on checks instead of your entire name.

If you lose your checks and a criminal wants to use them, he or she will not know how to sign your name. If your checks are stolen, it will be obvious if a criminal is using them if there are checks signed with just your initials. Whatever you do, don't sing your checks in advance for the sake of convenience. Only sign your checks after you have filled them out completely. A signed, blank check is a jackpot for a thief.

For credit cards, she suggested instead of signing each of your cards, write "Photo ID Required," in the signature block. This way, if someone steals your credit card, they may not be able to use it. Of course, you will have to show your

drivers license every time you make a purchase - a small price to pay for making it difficult for a thief to steal from you. Not all sales clerks check the signature block each time a credit card is used, but more and more do every day.

Another suggestion is to keep copies of everything. Time is of the excess when you lose your wallet, purse or checkbook. Being able to quickly call and cancel every credit account you will limit the damage an identity thief can do. an easy way to make sure you contact every single creditor is to have a separate copy of every card you carry in your purse or in your wallet. Photocopy the front and back of all your credit cards, debit cards, insurance cards, and anything you regularly carry in your wallet and store the copies in a safe place. In an emergency, you can refer to your copies to quickly call and cancel your accounts.

These suggestion may reduce your risk of identity theft, but are not comprehensive. Protect your personal information at all times and keep an eye on your financial records.
