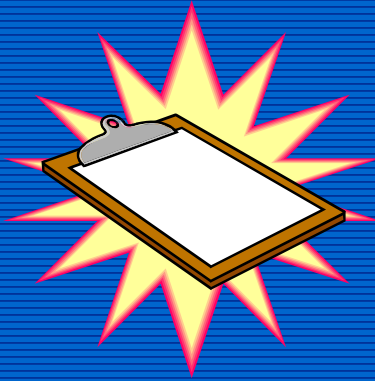


Lubbock Challenger League!
